DCOTA Executive Board Descriptions

President

The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Association and shall preside at all meetings of the Association membership and Board. The President shall appoint committee chairs for all standing committees of the Board subject to Board approval. The President shall have the power to sign all written obligations of the Association upon approval of the Board of Directors, and shall exercise general powers of supervision and active management of the Association.

Vice President

The Vice President shall assist the President as requested and assume presidential duties in the absence of the President. In the event of a vacancy in the office of the President, the Vice President shall succeed to the Presidency for the unexpired portion of the President's term. The vice president shall serve on the program committee or serve as chairperson act as liaison between all DCOTA continuing education and program activities.

Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be responsible for the conduct of the financial affairs of the Association and shall present a report at the annual business meeting. That report shall include a written statement of the Association's financial affairs and a budget of that year as approved by the Board. The Treasurer shall also monitor the DCOTA Scholarship Fund that is endowed with the American Occupational Therapy Foundation (AOTF).
